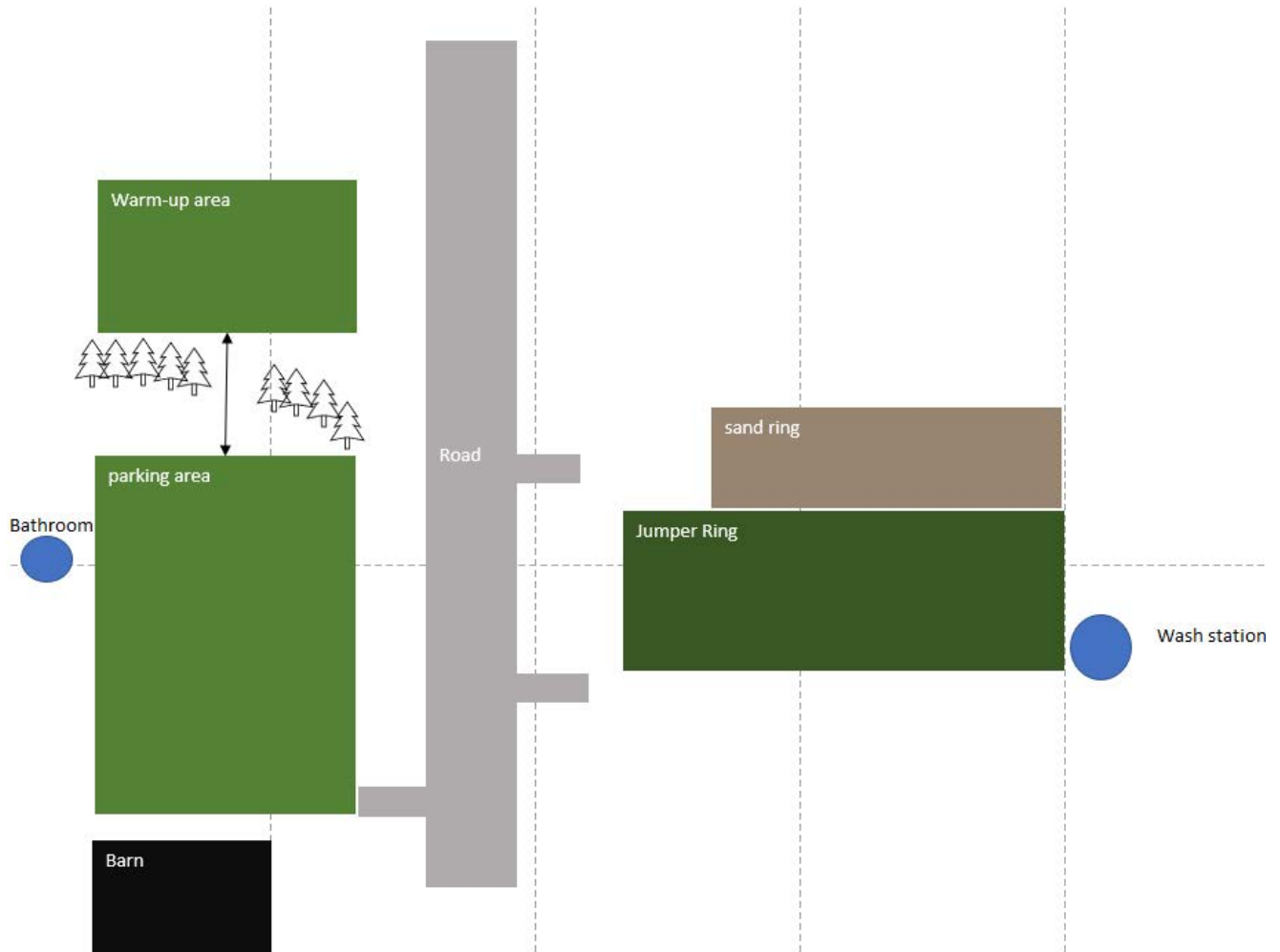

Show Package

Class descriptions and general rules

Lead line – Rider has never shown off-lead before and is not signed up for any other off-lead classes.

W/T – Classes are only ridden at the walk and trot; riders are not signed up for any canter classes.

W/T/C- Classes ridden at the walk, trot, and canter; riders not signed up for any W/T-only classes or leadline.

Equitation – Is judged based on the rider's position and overall impression.

Pleasure – Is judged based on the horse's gate and overall impression.

Command – Process of elimination based on commands called out via the judge.

Bareback – This class is ridden without a saddle in a command-style class, a process of elimination. The rider with the paper under their leg at the end of the class wins.

Jack Benny – Can be shown with a lead or solo, parents/guardians have a chance to go into the show ring in a command-style class.

POG – A jumper-style course of poles on the ground to be ridden at the W/T.

Crossrails – A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 18" at the center.

X' and O's - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 18" at the center with crossrails and verticals.

2ft - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 2ft at the center with verticals and oxers.

2.3ft - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 2.3ft at the center with verticals and oxers.

2.6ft - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 2.6ft at the center with verticals and oxers.

2.9ft - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 2.9ft at the center with verticals and oxers.

3ft - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 3ft at the center with verticals and oxers.

3.3ft - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 3.3ft at the center with verticals and oxers.

3.6ft - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 3.6ft at the center with verticals and oxers.

3.9ft - A jumper-style course with jumps not exceeding 3.9ft at the center with verticals and oxers.

Cross Country Beginner- A simple/safe course of small poles on the ground in the cross country field, to be ridden at the W/T

Cross Country Novice- A simple/safe course of small and medium size poles on the ground in the cross country field (W/T/C)

Cross Country Pre-Entry- A simple/safe course of jumps no bigger than 2.6ft in the cross country field (W/T/C)

Cross Country Entry- A simple/safe course of jumps no bigger than 2.9ft in the cross country field (W/T/C)

Open – Open to all ages, must not be signed up for a lead line class.

Junior – Rider is under the age of 18 as of October 2023

Senior – Rider is 18 or older as of October 2023

Jumper-style – This class is based on speed, the fastest time wins. There will be a 4-second penalty for every pole that is knocked down. A 4-second penalty for every refusal and/or run out. On the 3rd refusal or run out the rider is eliminated from placing but is allowed to finish the course au concourse if deemed safe by the show steward. This course is ridden in a fenced in arena,

Cross Country - 4 penalty points (1 second each) will be added on to the final time for each second under the ideal time. 1 penalty point (1 second each) will be added of to the final time for each second over the ideal time. On the 3rd refusal or run out the rider is eliminated from placing but is allowed to finish the course au concourse if deemed safe by the show steward. This course is ridden in an open cross country field.

- ✓ Riders that fall off must be seen by the onsite medic or nurse and decisions allowing the rider to re-mount will be based on their advice.
- ✓ No harsh treatment to horses or riders will be allowed on the show grounds. If the show Stewart is made aware of such behaviour, they hold the right to refuse entry of the parties involved.
- ✓ **Each horse rider combo needs to fill out a separate entry form that is attached.**
- ✓ 1st-6th place ribbons and prizes will be given out at each show with division champion awards given at the last show for W/T JR and SR, W/T/C JR and SR and each of the cross country divisions.
- ✓ Riders are encouraged to wear full show gear, although it is not mandatory. Neutral colored tights with a white polo tucked in and a over all neat and tidy appearance is acceptable.
- ✓ **Certified helmets are mandatory.**
- ✓ Appropriate riding boots are mandatory.
- ✓ Each rider must have a current NBEA #. (<https://www.nbea.ca/>)
